The apprentice is expected to gain experience in each of the following specific groups:

A. General Skills

- Site/Project Preparation and Maintenance
- Transportation, dismantling, and stockpiling of scaffolding and work platforms
- Grading, compaction, layout and staking protocols
- Rigging and signaling for work traditionally performed by Construction Craft Laborers
- Site preparation, clean-up and security

Hours: 600

B. Tools, Equipment and Materials

- Tool, equipment, and material recognition and preparation
- Hand electric, gas, pneumatic and power tool/equipment
- Use and maintenance
- Tool, equipment and material storage security

Hours: 600

C. Safety

- Confined space safety
- Flagging, signing, and traffic safety awareness
- Hazard material recognition
- Trenching and site excavation safety

Hours: 400

D. Environmental Remediation

- Asbestos Abatement
- Hazardous Waste Abatement
- Lead Abatement
- Petro-Chemical Abatement

Hours: 800

E. Building Construction

- Concrete (tending, placement, removal)
- Landscaping
- Mason/Plasterer Tending
- Pipe Laying

Hours: 800

F. Heavy/Highway Construction

- Drilling and blasting
- Pipe Laying for work traditionally performed by Construction Craft Laborers
- Tunnel and Shaft
