- Employers may require a valid driver's license and drug test
- VETERANS who have GI Benefits may use them in this program
- Graduates of a BOLI-approved Pre-Apprenticeship Program are encouraged to use this program

• Multnomah, Clackamas and Washington Counties

ON-THE-JOB TRAINING:

Approximately 2,000 hours of On the Job Training are required to complete this program.

RELATED TRAINING:

A minimum of 144 hours per year of classroom training is required to complete this program. Apprentices attend school one night per week through the regular school year.

WAGE SCHEDULE:

Apprentice wages are based upon the average wage for journey workers employed by participating training employers. The journey wage as of June 1, 2025 is \$24.00. Apprentices are paid a progressive percentage of that average journey wage as follows:

1st 1,000 hour period 2nd 1,000 hour period 75% of average wage 90% of average wage
